RE: Docket No. 20190185-WS - Application for authority to transfer assets of exempt entity in Sumter County by the City of Wildwood to South Sumter Utility Company, LLC.

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-2020-0264-PAA-WS, issued July 27, 2020, this docket shall be closed administratively upon staff's verification and approval that South Sumter Utility Company, LLC (SSU or Utility) had filed revised tariff sheets. The Order also required that the Utility notify the Commission in writing that general ledgers have been updated to reflect the Commission-approved balances as of September 19, 2020.

The revised tariff sheets were filed by the Utility and approved by staff with an August 25, 2020, effective date. On November 10, 2020, SSU notified the Commission in writing that its books have been updated to reflect the Commission-required accounting adjustments.

Staff has determined that the Utility has demonstrated compliance with Order No. PSC-2020-0264-PAA-WS, and requests that this docket be closed administratively.
