Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Peoples Gas System (PGS or Company) requests a temporary protective order and confidential classification of certain information filed in response to Office of Public Council (OPC) discovery, in the above referenced docket, dated July 16, 2020. This recommendation specifically addresses PGS's response to OPC's 5th interrogatories (ROG), No. 148.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its responses to OPC's 5th ROG, No. 148 under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Per the Statute, proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to; Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The information provided in response to OPC's ROG No. 148, for which a temporary protective order and confidential treatment are being sought, can be described as the names of PGS's capital projects that were internally approved and added to the capital budget after the Company's original filing.

Staff has reviewed the information PGS filed in response to OPC's ROG No. 148 as well as the Company's confidentiality request and request for a temporary protective order. It is staff's opinion that the information that is the subject of this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
