CUSTOMER COMMENTS

Residents of Seminole County have been hit with 100% increase in the past 5 years. This summarizes ONLY "BASE CHARGES" for water and wastewater on 1" meter:

2015 prior to filing rate increase: $\$11.14 + \$12.45 = \$23.59/\text{month}$

2017 prior to filing rate increase: $\$21.15 + \$13.09 = \$34.24/\text{month}$

2020 prior to filing rate increase: $\$28.20 + \$26.72 = \$54.92/\text{month}$

If approved BASE CHARGES will increase to $\$33.08 + \$35.44 = \$68.52/\text{month}$ (not including monthly consumption costs)!

$\$23.59$ in 2015 to $\$68.52/\text{month}$ if approved...

VOTE "NO"! The infrastructure improvements and customer service do NOT warrant this or any future increases, rates almost TRIPLED in 5 year period is OUTRAGEOUS.
