WE RAISED 4 CHILDREN IN THIS HOME AND CONSUMED MUCH MORE WATER IN THE FIRST 20 YEARS THAN WE PRESENTLY DO, WITH JUST THE 2 OF US NOW LIVING HERE. UP UNTIL ABOUT 5 YEARS AGO OUR WATER UTILITY BILL AVERAGED ABOUT \$26. PER MONTH. IT NOW AVERAGES ABOUT \$75. PER MONTH. I CAN'T UNDERSTAND THE NEARLY 300% INCREASE OVER THE LAST 5 YEARS FOR MINIMAL USAGE. HOW IS IT CONSCIENABLE TO CONSIDER ANOTHER INCREASE? ESPECIALLY IN THESE TOUGH TIMES.
