On November 13, 2020, the Office of Public Counsel submitted one copy of the prefiled testimony of Andrea C. Crane under UIF's claim of confidentiality. Some pages of that document were marked confidential. That testimony was given Document No. 11983-2020. This procedure was an interim measure, designed to enable OPC to adhere to the procedural schedule while providing UIF an opportunity to review the testimony and redact the material that it regarded as confidential.

On December 1, 2020, counsel for Utilities, Inc. of Florida ("UIF") withdrew the company's Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification regarding the prefiled testimony of Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") witness Andrea C. Crane. UIF stated it "determined that there is no confidential information in such testimony." At the request of the PSC's Staff Counsel, OPC attempted to re-file the prefiled testimony of OPC witness Andrea C. Crane without any markings designating pages confidential. This was given Document No. 13045-2020 in the above docket. However, Document No. 13045-2020 was filed in error and should be withdrawn as it may contain material covered by the work product privilege. As Document No. 13045-2020 was electronically filed, there are no documents that need to be returned to the Office of Public Counsel.
