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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Good morning, Commissioners.
3	We have everybody on-line. I think we've tested
4	all the microphones.
5	It's good to see everyone this morning.
6	Welcome to this Special Agenda Conference, Tuesday,
7	December 15th. We have a relatively short agenda
8	today, and we are going to take about a 15-minute
9	break after we handle this item and we will come
10	back for Internal Affairs immediately following.
11	I would like to invite everyone who would like
12	to do so to join me in an invocation this morning
13	followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
14	(Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.)
15	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All right. Our first and
16	only item today is fuel and purchased power cost
17	recovery clause, and Mr. Mark Futrell is going to
18	introduce the item for us.
19	Mark.
20	MR. FUTRELL: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, and
21	good morning, Commissioners.
22	Item No. 1 is Staff's recommendation
23	concerning Duke Energy Florida's petition for
24	revised fuel purchased power and capacity charges.
25	Following the hearing on November 3rd, 2020,

1	briefs were filed by Duke, the Office of Public
2	Counsel, Florida Industrial Power Users Group and
3	White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Incorporated,
4	on Issues 1A, 10, 11, 18, 20 and 22. The remaining
5	outstanding issues for Duke are considered fallout
6	issues which will be resolved on the Commission's
7	decisions in the aforementioned issues.
8	Duke requests the Commission reduce its
9	currently authorized fuel and purchased power
10	charges and increase its capacity charge. Combined
11	revisions would result in a net decrease to a
12	typical residential customer's monthly bill of
13	approximately 51 cents for the first 1,000 kilowatt
14	hours of electricity usage. The company requests
15	the revised charges become effective with the first
16	full billing cycle of the new year.
17	This is a post-hearing recommendation, and
18	participation is limited to Commissioners and
19	Staff, and Staff is available to answer questions.
20	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All right. Thank you, Mr.
21	Futrell.
22	All right. Commissioners, this is your
23	opportunity to ask any questions post-hearing.
24	What's your pleasure?
25	Any of questions from any Commissioner?

1	All right. No one has any questions on the
2	item.
3	All right. With that in mind, are you ready
4	to make a decision? I will entertain a motion.
5	Commissioner Brown.
6	COMMISSIONER BROWN: Yes, sir. Thank you.
7	And I think this is a very straightforward
8	recommendation, and I appreciate staff and the
9	parties participating in it. And with that, I
10	would move the staff recommendation on all issues.
11	COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Second.
12	CHAIRMAN CLARK: I have a motion and a second.
13	Any discussion on the motion?
14	All those in favor say aye.
15	(Chorus of ayes.)
16	CHAIRMAN CLARK: All opposed?
17	(No response.)
18	CHAIRMAN CLARK: Motion carries unanimously.
19	All right. That may go down as the fastest
20	hearing I have ever conducted, so thank you very
21	much.
22	We are going to adjourn, and we will reconvene
23	at 9:45. Can we turn it around by 9:45, David?
24	9:45 we will reconvene.
