To Whom It May Concern,

I am a property owner on Don Pedro Island (121 Kettle Harbor Drive), which is within the service area contained in the application from Environmental Utilities, LLC [EU] for central sewer. I object to EU's request for the bifurcation of the certificate and rate-making proceedings and I object to the granting of a temporary waiver of Rule 25-30.033(1)(p) and (q). Given the inadequate information that has been supplied so far regarding the applicant's financial strength and management experience, the applicant's request for a waiver should be denied.
