Docket No. 20200218-EI – Joint petition for approval of intermittent electric standby power agreement, by Tampa Electric Company, Duke Energy Florida, and Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC.

Issue 1: Should the Commission approve the proposed amendment to the intermittent electric standby power agreement between Tampa Electric, Duke, and Mosaic?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should approve the proposed amendment to the current intermittent electric standby power agreement between Tampa Electric, Duke, and Mosaic, effective on the date of a final Commission order approving the amendment. The amended agreement is consistent with the Commission’s policy of encouraging agreements, promotes renewable energy, and has no immediate impact on Tampa Electric’s and Duke’s general body of ratepayers.



