

By Order No. PSC-2020-0458-PAA-WS, issued November 23, 2020, in Docket No. 20190170-WS, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved the transfer of Royal Utilities Company’s water and wastewater systems and Certificate Nos. 259-W and 199-S to Royal Waterworks, Inc. (Royal or utility). The monthly water and wastewater rates you were paying to Royal Utilities, Inc. will remain unchanged unless and until a change is approved by the Commission. However, the Commission approved new miscellaneous service charges, a late payment charge, non-sufficient funds charges (NSF), and a new class of service for private fire protection to its tariff. The approved charges are set forth below.

- (4) 5 percent of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.
