Bear in mind this is a barrier bridgeless island and everything has to come over by BOAT or BARGE a lot of people don't comprehend the logistics of this.

This 2 man operation will cause financial hardships for everyone especially those who only use their properties for vacations and weekends. I, as a senior, do not rent my home and see no reason for myself, together with other owners, be forced to bear this burden.

Things to be considered.

Project be done by the county (if it was necessary) rather than a couple of people from a PO Box in Placida.

A PSC engineer study

Need of proposed site plan map with SECURED easements supplied to all homeowners as property is private.

Let homeowners have knowledge of Financial strength, stability and management experience

Type of Sewer system

Cost of Installation, proposed rates, connection fees

Already we have had to connect to potable water at a cost of \$5,000 and have a monthly fee for renting a meter (having to pay 3 months in advance \$234.69) then get charged for 1,000 galls of water even if it is not used and then if your home is empty for six months still charged to rent the meter. Wonder how much you are charged for renting your water meter. Can't imagine the costs for unnecessary sewers here.
