I am in total support of approving the proposal to provide wastewater service in Charlotte County by Environmental Utilities,LLC.

May you consider approving the Environmental Utilities proposal for this most important project. The following support this acceptance.

1. This improvement must be made as soon as possible. Some of the septic tanks are very old and need to be replaced. As you may know, the local septic maintenance companies. - Martin Septic, SOS and Englewood Environmental - are repairing

septic tanks often each week.

2. The Application for the certificate is for the installation of the sewer lines which will be connected to Charlotte County Waste Water treatment plan.
