Pursuant to Section 4.5.2 of AT&T Florida Self-Effectuating Enforcement Mechanisms Administration Plan ("SEEM Plan"), AT&T Florida declared a force majeure event that began February 15, 2021 in connection with severe winter storms.

As of the end of business on February 23, 2021, AT&T Florida hereby lifts the force majeure declaration for this event for all Service Quality Measures ("SQMs") associated with Ordering and Billing on a statewide basis.

AT&T Florida remains under its statewide force majeure declaration related to the COVID-19 virus for Provisioning and Maintenance & Repair SQMs; the declaration for these measures began on March 20, 2020.
