Dear Mr. Williams:

Sprint Communications Company, L.P., a wholly-owned subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“Sprint” or “T-Mobile”) and the Florida Public Service Commission (“Commission”) are parties to the Agreement to Provide Telecommunications Relay Service and Caption Telecommunications Service to Florida (“Agreement”). The first of the four 1-year extension terms of this Agreement is due to expire on February 28, 2022. Pursuant to Section 2 (“Contract Term”) of the Agreement and Section A.9. (“Term of Contract”) of the Request for Proposal, this letter shall serve as official notice to the Commission that Sprint is unable at this time to commit to further extension of the contract and therefore is providing notice of non-renewal. Sprint is providing this notice today in order to comply with the Agreement’s notice requirements; however, Sprint requests the opportunity to discuss the rationale for its decision and determine whether there is an opportunity for the parties to mutually agree to further renewal of the contract.
