**Re: Tampa Electric Company Revised Fuel Emergency Plan (filed on March 9, 2021)**

Dear Mr. Beasley,

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0185, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), electric utilities that own or control electric generation facilities are required to file a long-term energy emergency plan and periodic updates with both the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) and the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council. The utilities are required to review their plans every three calendar years and either submit a revised plan for Commission approval or provide a letter indicating the adequacy of the existing plan.

On March 9, 2021, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) filed its revised Long-Term Energy Emergency Plan (Document No. 02699-2021). Commission staff has reviewed TECO's Long-Term Energy Emergency Plan (Plan) and considers the revisions and overall procedures of the Plan to be consistent with the requirements of Rule 25-6.0185 F.A.C. Therefore, TECO's revised Plan is hereby administratively approved. Staff requests that TECO notify the Commission of any changes to its Plan as filed.
