Re: Orlando Utilities Commission Revised Fuel Emergency Plan (submitted on January 29, 2021)

Dear Ms. Notarnicola,

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0185, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), electric utilities that own or control electric generation facilities are required to file a long-term energy emergency plan and periodic updates with both the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) and the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council. The utilities are required to review their plans every three calendar years and either submit a revised plan for Commission approval or provide a letter indicating the adequacy of the existing plan.

On January 29, 2021, the Orlando Utilities Commission (OUC) provided its revised Fuel Emergency Plan (Plan) to Commission staff. Commission staff has reviewed OUC's Plan and considers the revisions and overall procedures of the Plan to be consistent with the requirements of Rule 25-6.0185 F.A.C. Therefore, OUC's revised Plan is hereby administratively approved. Staff requests that OUC notify the Commission of any changes to its Plan as filed.
