Dear Commissioner

Florida Power & Light is asking for the largest single rate hike in Florida history. Increasing the cost of electricity is something you, the Public Service Commission, can regulate.

It is unconscionable to think that I should have to pay such an exorbitant increase in my electric service. Rubber stamping an all-time high return on equity of 11.5 percent is unwarranted. This return on equity would be the highest in the nation and more than 2 percent above the U.S. average of 9.55 percent. Putting people over profits should come first.

A \$2 BILLION base-rate increase over the next 4 years — Really? This amounts to more than a 15 percent increase over four years. And FPL will seek other increases, such as additional storm-cost recovery fees, storm-hardening fees, and/or nuclear-cost recovery fees.

These increases are excessive. Please do not give FPL what it wants.
