The FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION announces a hearing in the following dockets to which all persons are invited.

DOCKET NOS. AND TITLES: 20200151-EI - Petition for approval of a regulatory asset to record costs incurred due to COVID-19, by Gulf Power Company. 20200194-PU - Petition for approval of regulatory assets to record costs incurred due to COVID-19, by Florida Public Utilities Company, Florida Public Utilities Company – Indiantown Division, Florida Public Utilities Company - Fort Meade, Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation.

HEARING DATE AND TIME: Thursday, July 8, 2021, immediately following conclusion of the Agenda Conference, which is scheduled to commence at 9:30 a.m.

PLACE: Room 148, Betty Easley Conference Center, 4075 Esplanade Way, Tallahassee, Florida. Attendance by any party, representative of a party, or witness at the hearing may be in person or virtual using the GoToMeeting Platform.

GENERAL SUBJECT MATTER TO BE CONSIDERED AT THE HEARING:

The purpose of this hearing is for the Florida Public Service Commission to take evidence upon which it will take final action to determine whether the Stipulation and Settlement dated June 11, 2021, in Docket No. 20210194-PU, and the Stipulation and Settlement dated June 15, 2021, in Docket No. 20210151-EI, regarding the establishment of regulatory assets and recovery of costs incurred due to COVID-19, are in the public interest.

This proceeding shall: (1) allow Gulf Power Company, Florida Public Utilities Company, and the Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation, to present testimony and other evidence in support of the Stipulations and Settlements; (2) permit the Office of Public Counsel to present testimony and other evidence concerning the Stipulations and Settlements; and (3) allow for such other proceedings relevant to the Stipulations and Settlements as the Commission may deem appropriate. All witnesses shall be subject to cross examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

The hearing will be governed by the provisions of Chapters 120 and 366, F.S.; and Chapters 25-22, 28-106, and 28-109, F.A.C.
