CHAIRMAN CLARK: Moving on to item No. 3, application for certificate to provide wastewater service in Charlotte County by EULLC. Ms. Mary Anne Helton will introduce the item for, please.

In Item No. 3, staff recommends that you deny Ms. Cotherman's motion for reconsideration of an order granting confidentiality to financial statements for Environmental Utilities, LLC. Staff recommends that the motion for reconsideration should be denied because it fails to identify a point of fact or law that was overlooked or that the pre-hearing officer failed to consider in rendering the order.

6 questions.


