RE: PSC meetings about this increase request will be held August 9-10 and October 2, and October 18-22.

I just found out that TECO is trying to increase our rates to a 40% increase in basic electrical charge, 26% increase for the first 1,000 KWH, and 22% increase for all above 1,000 KWH.

I do not approve of these rate increases. With the cost of inflation that is consistently increasing I can barely afford to purchase groceries for my family, not to mention the ridiculous gas prices.

Florida is increasing in numbers for housing and continues to build more communities without proper traffic control. The water department (BOCC) has just increased their rates as well. This is a slap in the face to the average working class people.
