PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM'S PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Peoples Gas System ("PGS") by its undersigned attorneys, submits the following Preliminary List of the Issues and Positions:

GENERIC CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY ISSUES

ISSUE 1: What are the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2020 through December 2020?

PGS: \$1,883,202 under-recovery

ISSUE 2: What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up amounts for the period January 2021 through December 2021?

PGS: \$927,574 under-recovery

ISSUE 3: What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amounts to be collected/refunded from the period January 2022 through December 2022?

PGS: A collection of \$2,810,776

What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2022 through December 2022?

PGS: A collection of \$26,011,848

<u>ISSUE 5</u>: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2022 through December 2022?

PGS:

ISSUE 6: Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the natural gas conservation cost recovery amounts and establishing natural gas conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in

this proceeding?

<u>PGS</u>: Yes, the Commission should approve revised tariffs reflecting the natural gas conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding.

<u>ISSUE 7:</u> What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

<u>PGS</u>: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2022 through December 2022. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2022, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2022, so that each customer is billed for 12 months regardless of when the factor became effective.

ISSUE 8: Should this docket be closed?

<u>PGS</u>: Yes, Docket No. 20210004-GU should be closed once the Commission's decisions on all of the issues in the docket have become final and the Commission has concluded that the docket has otherwise met the requirements for closure.
