St. Joe Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("SJNG") by and through its undersigned officer, hereby submits its Preliminary List of Issues and Positions to be taken up at the Hearing now scheduled to begin November 2, 2021 in the above listed docket.

Issue 1: What are the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts for the period January through December 2020?

SJNG's Position: \$17,251 over-recovery.

- Issue 3: What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amount to be collected/refunded from January 2022 through December 2022?

SJNG'S Position: \$81,077 over-recovery

- Issue 4: What is the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2022 through December 2022?
 SJNG's Position: An Under-recovery of \$122,398.
- Issue 5: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2022 through December 2022?

SJNG's Position: \$0.34498 per therm for RS-1, \$0.23544 per therm for RS-2, \$.18631 per therm for RS-3, \$.13503 per therm for GS-1, \$.06541 per therm for GS-2, and \$.04748 per therm for FTS-4.

Issue 6: Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the natural gas conservation cost recovery amounts and establishing natural gas conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?

Issue 7: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

SJNG'S Position: The effective date should be January 1, 2022.
