Request for Confidential Classification of Document No. 09691-2021

On August 24, 2021, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or utility) filed a request for confidential treatment for Document No. 09691-2021. This document contains confidential information provided in response to staff's fifth data request, No. 19, Part b and No. 23, Parts f and j. The confidential information contains a breakdown demonstrating how FPL determined the monthly charges for the Residential Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Pilot, the estimated cost of each smart panel in the Smart Panel Pilot, as well as a budgetary estimate of the cost to install the smart panel.

In its request for confidentiality, FPL asserts that the response provided on the Residential EV Pilot contains information relating to bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. FPL further states that the response provided on the Smart Panel Pilot contains information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. In addition, FPL states that the utility treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 09691-2021 as confidential.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with FPL that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the efforts of the utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. Disclosure of this information would also impair the competitive business operations of FPL. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by FPL for confidential classification of Document No. 09691-2021 be approved.
