

Provide explanation: NGA 911, L.L.C. (NGA) has requested that its application be considered at the September Agenda Conference in order to provide service for a contract recently awarded. NGA's certificate was cancelled on June 3, 2021, for failure to pay regulatory assessment fees (RAFs). NGA applied for recertification on August 25, 2021, and paid the \$500 first time non-compliance penalty directly to the FPSC. However, the Clerk's Office received this payment after the recommendation filing deadline on August 27, 2021. NGA also indicated that it paid the collection agency the 2020 RAFs, penalty, and interest on August 4, 2021. At the time recommendations were due, the collection agency had not confirmed these payments to the FPSC. On August 30, 2021, the collection agency confirmed that it has recovered the 2020 RAFs, penalty, and interest from NGA and will be submitted to the FPSC next month. NGA is in good standing to apply for certification.
