Dear Commissioner

If the PSC agrees with the settlement, it will allow FPL to avoid going on the record with answers to questions about its clean energy goals and its commitment to keeping its rates affordable.

The settlement includes investments in solar and electric vehicle infrastructure. Such subsidies are not needed as EV chargers can be installed by competitive providers. It also includes nearly \$20 million in industry association dues paid by customers with no requirement for FPL to prove how the dues are used to benefit customers which it should. FPL continues to be the only major utility with no absolute carbon emissions reduction goals, instead committing only to a reduction of carbon "intensity." Ironically, NextEra (FPL's parent) invests in clean energy projects around the country.....

I appreciate your addressing these issues as part of the deal.
