By Order No. PSC-2021-0320-PAA-WU, in Docket No. 20200230-WU, issued August 23, 2021, the Florida Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approved an increase in water rates and implemented a meter tampering charge in Manatee County for Sunny Shores Utilities, LLC (“utility”). The Commission also approved the utility’s request to remove the tariff charge for maintenance of customers’ backflow prevention devices. A schedule of Commission approved rates and charge are set forth below.
