# PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is for the Commission to consider the Agreement which is intended to settle the issues presented by Docket Nos. 20210034-EI - Petition for rate increase by Tampa Electric Company, and 20200264-EI - Petition for approval of 2020 depreciation and dismantlement study and capital recovery schedules, by Tampa Electric Company. The Commission may also consider any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement. This proceeding shall: (1) allow the parties to present evidence and testimony in support of their positions; (2) allow for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate.

All settlement panel witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony. The hearing will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, Chapter 366, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 25-22, 28-106, and 28-109, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C).
