C. <u>Statement of Basic Position:</u>

The Commission should approve the final adjusted net true-up amount for the twelve- month period ending December 31, 2021 including interest, the projected conservation program expenses for the twelve-month period ending Dec 31, 2022 and the Conservation Cost Recovery Factors to be applied to customer bills rendered for the twelve-month period ending December 31, 2022 as filed by SJNG.

D. <u>SJNG's position on each issue:</u>

**ISSUE 1.** What are the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2020 through December 2020?

**SJNG:** An over-recovery of \$17,251.

**ISSUE 2.** What are the appropriate conservation adjustment actual/estimated trueup amounts for the period January through December **2021**?

**SJNG:** Conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up is \$63,826 overrecovery.

**ISSUE 3.** What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amounts to be collected/refunded from January through December **2022**?

**SJNG:** The total conservation adjustment true-up amount to be refunded is **\$81,077 over-recovery.** 

**ISSUE 4.** What is the total conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the January through December **2022** period.

**SJNG:** The true-up amount to be collected is \$122,398 under-recovery.

**ISSUE 5.** What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January

**2022** through December **2022**?

**SJNG:** The appropriate factors are:
