
Re: Petition of Tampa Electric Company for Approval of Revised Underground Residential Distribution Tariff

Dear Mr. Teitzman:

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.078(3), Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company is required to file Commission Form PSC 1031, which sets out the cost differential between overhead and underground service for a low-density subdivision. On April 1, 2021, Tampa Electric filed a Petition for approval of revised underground residential tariffs in Docket No. 20210064. This Petition contains the information required for Form PSC 1031 and is still pending before the Commission. As a result, Tampa Electric is not filing Form PSC 1031 at this time but would be willing to file an updated Form PSC 1031 after the Commission rules on the company's outstanding Petition.
