Dear PSC Commissioners,

I am a homeowner on Palm Island and writing to formally request that the PSC deny EU's application for wastewater service to our island. This is an unnecessary service and poses risks and uncertainty to the sewer system and environment. Please see my major concerns below:

1. Costs. Mandatory hookup requirements, new equipment requirements to operate and monthly service costs - all at the homeowner's expense.
2. Risks. The proposed system reliability and maintenance is unproven. The applicant has not demonstrated any technical expertise with this type of project. There is no experience to safely and reliably run the proposed system.

3. Environmental. The impact of initial construction and the potential of future system failure. This alone should be enough reason to deny this project.

I urge you to take these concerns into consideration and deny the EU's application for wastewater service.
