#### NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION REGARDING DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC'S RESPONSE TO OPC'S SECOND SET OF INTERROGATORIES (NOS. 11-26) AND OPC'S SECOND REQUEST TO PRODUCE DOCUMENTS (NOS. 5-16)

Duke Energy Florida, LLC ("DEF" or the "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of documents or information provided in DEF's Response to the Office of Public Counsel's ("OPC") Second Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 11-26) and Second Request to Produce Documents (Nos. 5-16). The confidential responses and documents have been filed with the clerk and the redacted versions have been submitted as part of DEF's Responses to the respective interrogatory and requests. Specifically, DEF's response to Interrogatory No. 13 and Request to Produce Nos. 5, 7, and 10, contain confidential proprietary business information relating to competitive business information of both DEF and third-party companies. The disclosure of this information to the public could adversely affect the Company's competitive business interests and efforts to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. Furthermore, the release of this information could adversely impact the proprietary rights of third parties, therefore impacting the company's competitive interest and ultimately have a detrimental impact on DEF's customers.

A highlighted copy of the above-referenced confidential documents labeled as Exhibit A, has been filed under a separate cover letter.

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(1), DEF will file its Request for Confidential Classification for the confidential information contained herein within twenty-one (21) days of filing this request.
