Dear Mr. Johnson:

The Public Service Commission (Commission) has received and reviewed your status report dated March 23, 2022, as required by Order No. PSC-2019-0357-PAA-EU (Order). Condition three of the Order granting waiver requires Calypso Tower III (Calypso) to allocate the cost of electricity to individual owners using a reasonable apportionment method as required by Rule 25-6.049(9)(a), F.A.C.

In your response to condition three of the Order, the status report states that "the cost of electricity to the individual owners is billed using a reasonable apportionment method pursuant to Rule 25-6.049(9)(a), F.A.C." To comply with condition three of the Order, Calypso must demonstrate that it meets this requirement. Therefore, please give a detailed explanation of the apportionment method used to allocate electricity costs to individual customers of Calypso. Additionally, please provide a copy of a recent electric bill issued to a permanent resident of Calypso.
