Pursuant to Rule 25-30.457(8)(a), F.A.C., and the order in this docket, the utilities referenced above filed the required earnings review forms with the Commission on March 16, 2022.<sup>1,2</sup> Subsequent to the initial filing, the utilities submitted several revised pages on March 29, 2022.<sup>3</sup> Staff has reviewed the utilities' earnings forms and determined that Alturas Water, LLC; East Marion Utilities, LLC; Pinecrest Utilities, LLC; and Sunrise Water, LLC have not exceeded the range of their last authorized returns on equity and no refunds are required. According to Rule 25-30.457(8)(c), F.A.C., each utilities' respective revenue increase will no longer be held subject to refund.
