RE: Docket No. 20220068-TP – Notice of adoption of existing interconnection, collocation and resale agreement between NuVox Communications, Inc. and Embarq Florida, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink by Metro Fibernet, LLC d/b/a MetroNet.

By letter received March 29, 2022, Metro Fibernet, LLC d/b/a MetroNet filed a notice of adoption of the existing interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement between Embarq Florida, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink and NuVox Communications, Inc. which was deemed approved by the Commission in Docket No. 20070239-TP. Metro Fibernet, LLC d/b/a MetroNet is adopting the agreement pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety. Any exception to said obligation is governed by 47 U.S.C. § 51.809(b) and may be filed when such exception exists.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on April 21, 2022. The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.b. of the Administrative Procedures Manual in that it complies with Section 252(i) of the Act. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
