To whom it may concern, I am a resident that owns at 9274 Little Gasparilla Island. Regarding the new sewer system being imposed upon the residents, I think you should know that the last time that we had our septic tank inspected and pumped Martin Septic made it clear that the roads are not conducive for a septic pumping truck to enter our road in the future due to the overgrowth of the trees and property owners planting on the right of way. We not only have to pay a barge fee but also a premium price for the service. Also, with Eldred's Marina up for sale and the county refusing to put in a barge landing area, another issue will be faced for LGI owners as a septic pumping truck has to be barged over from the mainland.
