Subject: FPL Service Fee increase

Hello,

My electric company is FPL. I have solar panels which usually provides close to or above my electric consumption. I have been paying a service fee for a few years of \$9.84 when I generate more power than I use in a month. About a year ago the service fee increased to \$10.84. Today I just received a new bill for \$29.96. With no power bought from FPL. In the bill there is a statement that this increase was approved by the Florida Pubic Service Commission(FPSC). In researching articles published by FPSC I was unable to find any reference to this. This increase is almost triple (300%) of what was being charged by FPL. IS this legitimate? If so, why lay such a drastic increase on consumers who have spent an enormous amount of money to buy and install solar power? It seems to me that FPL has been granted a large money grab for nothing.
