You are meeting this week to discuss adding more charges to Florida Power and Light customers in Northwest Florida. FPL in its quarter report from April reported "first-quarter 2022 net income of \$875 million, or \$0.44 per share, compared to \$777 million, or \$0.39 per share, for the prior-year comparable quarter." So, they made \$98 million dollars *more. The cost of repairs following a hurricane are a cost of doing business. Sally and Zeta were not that bad, overall.
