RE: Docket No. 20210093-WS - Application for transfer of water and wastewater systems of Aquarina Utilities, Inc., water Certificate No. 517-W, and wastewater Certificate No. 450-S to CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC, in Brevard County.

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-2022-0115-PAA-WS (Order), issued March 15, 2022, CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR or Utility) was required 1) to notify the Commission in writing that its books have been adjusted in accordance with the Commission's decision; and 2) submit the executed and recorded warranty deed and copies of its applications for permit transfers to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the Saint Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD) within 60 days of the Order. The Order also advised that this docket shall be closed administratively in the event the Order becomes final and the aforementioned actions are completed.

The Order became final pursuant to Order No. PSC-2022-0133-CO-WS, issued on April 8, 2022. On May 23, 2022, CSWR provided a copy of the executed and recorded warranty deed for the land upon which its facilities are located. On May 25, 2022, the Utility provided copies of its applications to the DEP and SJRWMD for the respective permit transfers. On July 6, 2022, CSWR notified the Commission in writing that its books have been updated to reflect the Commission-required accounting adjustments. Staff has determined that the Utility has demonstrated compliance with Order No. PSC-2022-0115-PAA-WS, and requests that this docket be closed administratively.
