I am filing this complaint to the Florida Public Service Commission ("the Commission) and FPL's Board of Directors. A new FPL minimum charge of \$16.01 was added to my monthly base charge of \$8.99 to bring my account balance to \$25.00 for my June 21, 2022 month ended bill.

Of course my bill will be below the new minimum balance threshold of \$25.00, due to my Solar Panels and energy conservation practices in our house. This additional charge is basically a penalty for someone like myself with Solar Panels yielding a balance below \$25.00, during a given month. I do not use the central air condition during the fall and winter months (October thru April). My family and I, we see no reason to use the central air condition in our house, 24 hours a day, when it is eighty degrees or lower with a nice cool strong breeze outside. As a result, we build up enough kWh reserves to get through the early months of the summer with no charge except the base charge. So now I am being penalized for this. I need FPL's and the Florida Public Service Commission, underlying basis to justify this additional charge. If FPL's underlying basis is to contribute to the overall upkeep of the electrical grid, then individuals such as myself should be given reciprocal treatment toward our equipment which we purchased to save money and simultaneously help take stress off of their grid hence equipment. A win win situation one would think.

I was informed that in addition to the minimum base billing, Senate Bill 1024 and House Bill 741, if enacted, will change the current net metering regulation. FPL will pay credit at a non retail rate, which more than likely would be an Average Wholesale Rate (AWR) price that suggest that each individual Solar Panel owner are Electricity Distributors. So the retail rate will exceed the AWR. That was not the agreement that the State regulators allowed Solar Panel Company's sale persons to pitch to the State of Florida residents. Also I am not registered as a Electricity Distributor Company, nor was that my intention to resell electricity back at a rate not equal to rate I was charged for, when I purchased the Solar Panels. In fact, I have not saved a penny with these Solar Panels, it actually cost me slightly more than if I didn't have the solar panels. I can explain, in detail if requested to.

This is totally wrong ethically and not right, by not disclosing to electric consumers this new minimum base charge along with the State of Florida legislative bills discussed above. It is an attack in the State of Florida by the State of Florida Legislature and respective Electric Companies, against the purchase of Solar Panels. This is mind boggling and somewhat shameful for those proposing these legislative bills. There is no rational for this. I respectfully request reversal of this additional charge for minimum balance charge and a credit for those additional charges that have been incurred on my account.
