**JOINT REPORT OF
PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM AND
FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY
ON STATUS OF TERRITORIAL AGREEMENTS**

In Order No. PSC-03-0486-PAA-GU issued on April 14, 2003, in Docket No. 020670-GU, the Florida Public Service Commission (“Commission”) approved the amended and restated territorial agreement between Peoples Gas System, a division of Tampa Electric Company (“PGS”) and Florida Public Utilities Company (“FPUC”) ((the “2003 Agreement”). Section 3.5 of the 2003 Agreement calls for a meeting of the parties prior to the second anniversary of the effective date of the 2003 Agreement (and no more than every fifth anniversary thereafter), with a joint report on the status of the 2003 Agreement to be submitted to the Commission following such meetings.

In Order No. PSC-11-0404-PAA-GU issued on September 23, 2011, in Docket No. 110192-GU, the Commission approved the amended and restated territorial agreement between PGS and FPUC (the “2011 Agreement”). Section 6 of the 2011 Agreement calls for a meeting of the parties prior to the second anniversary of the effective date of the 2011 Agreement (and no more than every fifth anniversary thereafter), with a joint report on the status of the 2011 Agreement to be submitted to the Commission following such meetings.

In Order No. PSC-12-0230-PAA-GU issued on May 9, 2012, in Docket No. 110277-GU, the Commission approved the territorial agreement between PGS and FPUC (the “2012 Agreement”). Section 6 of the 2012 Agreement calls for a meeting of the parties prior to the second anniversary of the effective date of the 2012 Agreement (and no more than every fifth anniversary thereafter), with a joint report on the status of the 2012 Agreement to be submitted to the Commission following such meetings.

By this report, PGS and FPUC can advise the Commission that the 2003 Agreement, the 2011 Agreement and the 2012 Agreement (collectively, the “Territorial Agreements”) (i) remain in full force and effect, (ii) no modifications have been proposed in the terms of the Territorial Agreements; and (iii) no disputes between the parties have arisen concerning the provisions of the Territorial Agreements.

The parties will advise the Commission to the extent any changes to the Territorial Agreements identified herein are proposed and will petition the Commission to resolve any disputes which may arise with respect to the provisions of the Territorial Agreements if the parties are unable to resolve the same.
