**DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC’S
PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS**

Duke Energy Florida, LLC (“DEF”) hereby submits its Preliminary List of Issues and Positions with respect to its Energy Conservation Cost Recovery factors for the period of January through December 2022 pursuant to Order No. PSC-2022-0053-PCO-EG issued February 7, 2022¹.

GENERIC ECCR ISSUES

ISSUE 1: What are the final conservation cost recovery adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2021 through December 2021?

DEF: The adjusted net true-up for the period January 2021 through December 2021 is an over-recovery of \$10,606,390. (Rodriguez)

ISSUE 2: What are the appropriate conservation adjustment actual/estimated true-up amounts for the period January 2022 through December 2022?

DEF: \$3,762,001 adjusted net true-up under-recovery. (Rodriguez)

ISSUE 3: What are the appropriate total conservation adjustment true-up amounts to be collected/refunded in the period January 2023 through December 2023?

DEF: \$ 6,844,389 adjusted net true-up over-recovery. (Rodriguez)

ISSUE 4: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2023 through December 2023?

DEF: \$112,815,132. (Rodriguez)

ISSUE 5: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2023 through December 2023?

ISSUE 6: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

DEF: The new factors should be effective beginning with the first billing cycle for January 2023, and thereafter through the last billing cycle for December 2023. The first billing cycle may start before January 1, 2023, and the last billing cycle may end after December 31, 2023, so long as each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the factors became effective. (Rodriguez)

ISSUE 7: Should the Commission approve revised tariffs reflecting the energy conservation cost recovery amounts and energy conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding?

DEF: Yes. The Commission should approve DEF's revised tariffs reflecting the energy conservation cost recovery amounts and energy conservation cost recovery factors determined to be appropriate in this proceeding. The Commission should direct Staff to verify that the revised tariffs are consistent with the Commission decision. (Rodriguez)

ISSUE 8: Should this docket be closed?

DEF: Yes. (Rodriguez)
