COMPLAINT INFORMATION

Complaint: Other Complaint against Florida Power & Light Company
Details:

This is actually a complaint about the PSC's approval of the new \$25 minimum base bill. The above referenced account is for an EV charger that was installed approx. 2 years ago at our condominium. We have previously been paying a minimum of \$10.76 (including taxes and fees). This seemed reasonable. Our condo owners currently include 3 with electric vehicles that are ONLY in residence during the winter season (approx. October-May). And since these 3 owners are responsible for ALL charges related to the EV charging station, a 178% increase in the base fee we are paying; especially when we're not there, seems completely unreasonable. If you are trying to discourage the use of EVs by visitors and part-time residents, this is a good way to do it.
