On August 16, 2022, Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula or Company) filed a request for confidential treatment for Document No. 05484-2022. This document contains confidential information from Exhibit A to the firm transportation service agreement with Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC). The confidential information contained relates to the maximum daily transportation quantity, the maximum hourly transportation percentage, the monthly reservation charge, and the monthly reservation charge on per dekatherm/per day basis.

In its request for confidentiality, Peninsula asserts that disclosure of this information would cause harm to both the Company and FPUC, as the information relates to competitive interests. Furthermore, Peninsula states that both the Company and FPUC treat the highlighted information provided in Document No. 05484-2022 as confidential.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with Peninsula that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the competitive business operation of Peninsula. Therefore, staff recommends the request by Peninsula for confidential classification of Document No. 05484-2022 be approved.
