Complaint: Other Complaint against Duke Energy Florida, LLC d/b/a Duke Energy
Details:

WFLA reports that Duke Energy has filed for a rate increase of 15% for 2023, the highest increase of the three companies seeking a rate increase. FP&L is asking for a 7.9% increase. Duke Energy already charges more per KWH than any other major electric utility company in FL per the 9/22 issue of Florida Trend Magazine:

Duke Energy - \$201/1,500 KWH

FP&L - \$156/1,500 KWH

OUC - \$169/1,500 KWH

Kissimmee - \$173/1,500 KWH

This is rate increase is ridiculous and should not be approved!
