Boil water notices are frequent because of pipe leaks. They haven't kept the water mains up. Since I have lived in Swiss Village there have been many water leaks that were just patched with the hopes that the 40+ year old pipes won't leak again. Swiss Village Utilities has been known to just cover up problems and not address the real problems.
