I am writing as a concerned Florida resident and a electricity customer. I received notification that FPL, Duke and Tampa Electric intend to increase rates for customers like me. I am urging you to rethink this decision and not increase our bills.

This past year has been extremely challenging financially for many people in the state of Florida. As a senior on a partially fixed income, with less than half the work I had prior to the pandemic, with a disabled partner, electric rate increases of the magnitude suggested by the Florida electricity utilities are devastating!
