9 So tomorrow I am going to go down and just be 10 with them and helping in the restoration efforts 11 any way that I can, so -- but just thank you for 12 giving me the time to just say a few words for all 13 those people we are thinking and praying about you, 14 so thank you.

COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Commissioner Clark.

16 COMMISSIONER CLARK: I just want to say as 17 well, our hearts go out to the individuals who are 18 suffering through the damages that this hurricane Four years ago, the Panhandle went through 19 caused. 20 a very similar incident, and we are still, four 21 years later, seeing the effects. It's going to be 22 a long recovery process. 23 I just want to encourage those individuals who are experiencing -- still experiencing power 24

25 outage, who have experienced the loss of their
