This is my second submission due to the date change, rescheduled due to Hurricane Ian. Both of my submissions are different. I'm wondering why they need this extra money and what CHC VII, LTD plans to spend it on. I must reiterate that we are 55+ aged group of residents. I am age 76 and we have many residents in their 90s. Also we have many widows and widowers. I am a widow who lost the financial income of my husband who died 11/27/2021. I have not received any increases in my personal income. The inflation rate has caused price increases on everything. Many food items have doubled in price. Lawn services, pest control companies, our lot rent for land in our park went up the legal limit (although a small percentage reduction was given by the owning company) raising our rent for many residents by almost \$50 per month. The money we have to spend on Florida's economy is decreasing because people just have to be very frugal to survive. Many people are leaving the state because the cost of living has a negative impact. This increase should be postponed until our economy improves.
