Good Morning,

This email is a follow up to our phone conversation from yesterday morning. As we discussed, QCSTelecom, Inc. (TY172) is filing for a voluntary cancellation of their certificate (#8937). Our Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) system shows that the company is current on their RAF payments through the 2021 billing period. However, in accordance with Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code and Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, if a company has an active certificate for any portion of the RAF billing cycle, they will owe at least the minimum RAF's for that billing cycle, which is \$600 for CLX service providers.

Since you decided to go ahead and prepay your RAFs for 2022 in keeping with the afore-mentioned Rule and Statute, I have attached a copy of the RAF return form. Instructions for filling out and mailing the form are on the second page of the attachment. Please let me know if you have any additional questions or need further assistance.
