1 PROCEEDINGS

2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. If everybody could
3 grab your seats, we will get started.

4 Commissioner Graham, if you could provide us
5 with the invocation and the pledge this morning.
6 You are welcome to join if you would like to.

7 (Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.)

8 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Thank you,
9 Commissioner Graham.

10 With that, we will call this January 10 Agenda
11 Conference to order. Commissioners, we will take
12 up Items 3 and 4 through the move staff process,
13 and then take up Items 1 and 2 at the end for
14 further discussion.

15 So with that, I will let Ms. Guffey get
16 situated here and she will be presenting Items 3
17 and 4 this morning for us. So, Ms. Guffey,
18 whenever you are ready, you are recognized to
19 present summary on Item No. 3.

20 MS. GUFFEY: Thank you, Commissioners, Seveni
21 Guffey with the Commission staff.

22 Item 3 is a joint petition from the City of
23 Gulf Breeze and the Okaloosa Gas District
24 requesting approval of a new territorial agreement
25 in southern Santa Rosa County. The joint

1 petitioners seek to comply with Chapter 2021-262
2 Laws of Florida and the legislative directive that
3 the disputed area in southern Santa Rosa County may
4 be determined by Commission order.

5 The parties mutually agreed upon a dividing
6 line in the disputed area, and the proposed
7 agreement will formalize the dividing line and
8 delineate their service boundaries. The new
9 agreement will result in the transfer of one Gulf
10 Breeze residential customer and associated
11 facilities to the Okaloosa Gas District.

12 Staff recommends approval of this joint
13 petition by the City of Gulf Breeze and Okaloosa
14 Gas District.

15 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Thank you, Ms. Guffey.

16 Commissioners, you have a summary of Item No.
17 3. I will take a motion on this item at this time.

18 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move staff
19 recommendation, Mr. Chairman.

20 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second.

21 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. We have a motion and a
22 second.

23 All that approve say aye.

1 Item 3 passes unanimously.


