2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Next we will move to  
3 Item No. 8. Mr. Hampson will be presenting that  
4 item.

5 MR. HAMPSON: Item 8 is a joint petition for  
6 approval of a transportation service agreement  
7 between Florida Public Utilities Company and  
8 Peninsula Pipeline Company to reflect expansion of  
9 the Wildlight Development in Nassau County. The  
10 joint petitioner are subsidiaries of Chesapeake  
11 Utility Corporation, and agreements between  
12 affiliated companies must be approved by the  
13 Commission pursuant to Section 368.105, Florida  
14 Statutes.

15 Subject to the proposed agreement, Peninsula  
16 will construct, own and maintain new pipeline  
17 facilities to enhance FPUC's ability to provide and  
18 expand natural gas service in Nassau County. The  
19 proposed agreement specifies an initial term of 20  
20 years continuing on a year-by-year basis after the  
21 initial term.

22 Staff recommends the Commission should approve  
23 the proposed agreement between FPUC and Peninsula.  
24 The proposed agreement is reasonable and meets the  
25 requirements of Section 368.105, Florida Statutes.

1           CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. Thank you for  
2 presentation of that item, Mr. Hampson.

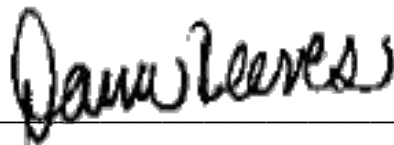
